Assigns for ever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son Parrot Robert
Puffet Crum the Plantation whereon I now live
containing One hundred and thirty Seven Acres
land or some more or less to him his Heirs forever.

Item I give unto my Son Micheal Crum a feather Bed
and furniture.

Item I give unto my Son Barnaby Crum a feather Bed
and furniture.

Item My Will and Desire is that after my Just Debts
and Legacies are paid all the residue of my Estate
to wit

land & came more or less to him his Heirs forever
I give unto my Son Michael Coom a feather Bed
and furniture.

I give unto my Son Barnaby Coom a feather Bed
and furniture.

My Will and Desire is that after my Just Debts
and Legacies are paid all the residue of my Estate
of what nature soever be equally divided among
my Wife and ten Children, to Wit, Joseph, Barnaby,
William, Moses, Michael, Elijah, Mary, Arthur, Sarah,
& Parnet Robert Popper Coom. And lastly I
do appoint my Son William my whole and
sole Executor of this my last Will and Testa-
ment In Witness whereof I do hereunto set
my hand and Seal this 17th Day of Oct^r 1756.
