do hereby certify that my last will and testament by me made
and bearing date

in witness whereof I have signed my soul to God that gave it me and
to my true intent and as for what worldly goods the Lord
has entrusted me with in the manner following

Item I have given and bequeathed to my Brother Henry Harrison during his natural life
the sum of ten pounds yearly to be paid to him by my Brother Benjamin Richard and Nathaniel
Harrison the sum of ten pounds yearly to each of them by my Brother Benjamin
Richard and Nathaniel Harrison and after his decease to his son Henry Harrison
to him and his heirs forever

Item I have given and bequeathed to my Brother Richard Harrison my
share of the land and his heirs forever

Item I have given and bequeathed to my sister Sarah all the land and
the sum of ten pounds yearly to be paid to her by my Brother Benjamin
Richard and Nathaniel Harrison and after his decease to his son Henry Harrison
to him and his heirs forever

Item I have given and bequeathed to my son Henry the sum of three
pounds yearly to be paid to him by my Brother Benjamin Richard and Nathaniel Harrison
and after his decease to his son Henry Harrison to him and his heirs forever

My desire is that the rest of my estate be sold and after my just
debts paid to be equally divided between my Brothers Henry and
Nathaniel Richard and Nathaniel Harrison

And do constitute and appoint my Brothers Henry and Richard
Harrison Executors of this my last will In witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and fixed my seal this fourth day of June
in the year of our Lord the thousand seven hundred and seventy

seven to wit the said William Harrison

To all whom these letters shall come

I leave and bequeath to my Brother Henry Harrison my
share of the land and his heirs forever

I leave and bequeath to my sister and all her heirs
and friends forever and ever

I leave and bequeath to my son at Henry Harrison the sum of £100
pounds for his education

My desire is that the rest of my estate be sold and after my just
debts paid to be equally divided between my Brothers Henry and
Patrick Harrison

I do constitute and appoint my Brothers Henry and Patrick
Harrison Executors of this my last will In Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and fixed my seal this fourth day of June
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and seventy
