In the year one thousand seven hundred and fifty eight I William
Ingraham of the County of Southampton do make this my
Will last Will and Testament in Manner and Form following
I Give unto my Son John the Plantation wherein I
live with one hundred and seventy Acres of Land or the
same more or less It being the first Survey made
on Norwake Pararch and also on Ware to him and
his heirs forever

I Give to my Son William the last Survey I
 have got a Patent for which joins the first and also
 one house to him and his heirs forever

I Give unto my Loving Wife the Use of all the
 Resremainder of my Estate after my Funeral Expenses
 and just Debts are paid and after the Death of my Wife
 I give it to be equally to be divided between my three Sons
 and two Daughters share and share alike

And lastly I do hereby make and ordain my Loving Wife
 my full and sole Executor of this my Last Will and Testament
 And I do hereby make void all Former and other Wills
 by me made And do establish this to be my Last Will
 and Testaments In Witness whereof I have caused my
