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In the Name of God Amen. I W^m Kemble of the parish of St. Luke & St. Mary of St. Mary being sick and weak but of sound and disposing mind and memory thank be given to almighty God for the same do make and constitute this to be my last will & testament in full and permanent manner following to wit

I give and bequeath unto my son Edwin Kemble my Plantation and Tract of Land whereon I now live containing 350 Acres to the said son or his heirs after the death of his mother to him and his heirs forever

I give to my loving wife Ann Kemble the labour of my two slaves Brister and Phillis during her Natural life and after her death I give and bequeath the said slaves to my son Edwin Kemble to him and his heirs forever I likewise give to my son Edwin Kemble my young Tamarbull commonly call

I give and bequeath unto my loving son Ed Kemble my Neg^{ro} Girl named Phillis to him and his heirs forever Together with my Tamarbull that we call Strin further more my will and desire is that my Coffin still with appropriate rances hereunto belonging remain on my said Plantation for the use of the owners I likewise give to my wife Ann her choice of one feather bed and my Copper Kettle further my will and desire is that after my just debts and funeral Expenses is paid that all the remaining part of my Estate not before mentioned

both real & Personal to be equally divided between my sons Jacob and
Shadrach Kennebec to them and their heirs forever And I do appoint
my Loving wife Ann my two sons Jacob & Shadrach Kennebec my
sole and sole Exors of this my Last will and Testament hereby
Reversing all other wills and bequest made & do declare
this to be my Last will & none other In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and fixed my Seal this 19 day of November 1772
