

Whereas I William Vick of Southampton County being through age weak of Body
 but of Sound and disposing mind and memory and considering the uncertainty of
 life as well as Certainty of age think proper and Necessary to Settle my Temporal
 Affairs by this thing Writing in manner and form following

I intend all my estate for my Children but desire my wife Elizabeth Vick may have
 the use of it during Life.

I give and demise my plantation with two hundred & forty Acres of land belonging
 to it to my Son Simon Vick and to his heirs and assigns forever

I give to son one hundred Acres of land more or less on east side of the little
 Swamp passing on from said Swamp by corner tree and line of Eze Brooks
 Williams to line and line of my Plantation tract these by various Courses of
 said Swamp to the beginning to hold to my said Son Simon Vick and
 assigns forever

I give to son seventy Acres of land more or less being part of a tract of which
 I gave Simon Charles A parcel Bounded by his line my plantation tract
 line my son William Vick's line and Puckly Ash Branch to hold to
 Son Simon Vick and his heirs and assigns forever

I give and demise to my son Robert two hundred Acres of land more or less

I give said Son one Negro Peter to hold to said Son Simon Vick his heirs and assigns forever Also ten pounds or half my Distillery utensils

Item I give and Demise to my Son Robert two hundred Acres of Land more or less lying on West side of the little Swamp being the same parcel of Land whereon he lives Bounded by my Plantation tract line Mathew Vicks line Darises Bryants Line Thomas Vicks line and the aforesaid Swamp to hold to my s^d Son Robert Vick and the heirs of his Body lawfully begotten forever.

Item I give and demise to aforesaid son Robert Vick one Negro Rose to hold to him his heirs and assigns forever also ten pounds or half my Distillery utensils

Item I give and Demise to my Granddaughter Rebecca Pope one hundred Acres of Land more or less desiring that her Mother Mary Pope may have the use of it during life Bounded by the pretty Ash Branch thence by a line in the same direction to a pine on son William Vicks line near near the fish Road thence to a corner tree of William Fowlers thence by Simon Barts line to aforesaid Branch to hold to my aforesaid granddaughter Rebecca Pope and to the heirs of her Body lawfully Begotten forever

Item I give my Son William Vick five Shillings

Item I give all the remainder of my estate undisposed of by this my will to be equally divided after my wifes decease among my after named Children Viz Simon Vick Robert Vick Isaac Vick Elizabeth Pope Mary Pope, Marsh Barts

Item I constitute and appoint my Sons Simon and Robert Vick Executors of this my Will Declaring this writing to be my last Will and In witness whereof

in June on son William Vicks line near the fish Road thence to a corner
tree of William Fowlers thence by Simon Barts line to aforesaid Branch
to hold to my aforesaid granddaughter Rebecca Pope and to the heirs of her
Body lawfully Begotten forever

Item I give my Son William Vick five Shillings

Item I give all the remainder of my estate undisposed of by this my will to be equally
divided after my wifes decease among my after named Children Viz Simon
Vick Robert Vick Isaac Vick Elizabeth Pope Mary Pope & Marsh Baret

Item I constitute and appoint my Sons Simon and Robert Vick Executors of
this my Will Testoreing this writing to be my last Will and In witness whereof
I have therunto set my hand and seal this fifteenth day of February one
Thousane Seven hundred and Seventy Seven
