The Condition of this obligation is that whereas the above bound Charles Gordon is appointed Guardian to Mary Gordon Orphan of John Gordon Deceased if therefore the said Charles Gordon Guardian aforesaid his heirs Executors & Admins shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid to the said orphan all such as now due or shall appear to be due to the said orphan when or as soon as the said orphan shall attain to lawfull age or when she is required by the said Justices their heirs or Successors as aforesaid and keep harmless the said Justices their heirs and Successors from all troubles Damages that shall or may accrue about the said Estate or Estates then the said obligation to be Void and of none Effect otherwise to remain in full force and Virtue
