after my said Will and Dispose of Effects above mentioned (Except

And the residue of my wearing Apparel I Give to be at the Dispo-
sal of Mr. Alice Allen for the use of my son Philip until
or to be Disposed of as he may think proper.
I Give to Margaret Allen Alice Middle one Gold Ring.
And I do hereby Appoint Mr. James Allen my sole Ex^{rs} of this
my will signed sealed and Delivered by the Testatrix as her
Last Will and Testament this Twelfth Day of Dec. One thousand
