 of Virginia to the Payment whereof well and truly to be made to the said
 Justices and their Successors we bind our selves and each of us and each of
 our heirs Executors and Administrators jointly & severally firmly by these
 presents sealed with our seals this 3^d Day of April 1769.

The Condition of this obligation is such that whereas the above bound
 Dmilla Widom is appointed Guardian to Thomas Widom orphan of
 John Widom Deceased if therefore the said Dmilla Widom Guardian do
 forward her heirs Ex. & Admin. shall well and truly pay or cause to be
 paid to the said orphan all such arrears due or shall appear to be due
 to the said orphan when or as soon as the said orphan shall attain to
 Lawfull age or when thereto required by the said Justices their heirs
 Successors or also save harmless the said Justices their heirs and
 Successors from all trouble damage that shall or may come about
 the said Estate or Estates then the said obligation to be void and of
 no Effect otherwise to stand and remain and be in full force and
 Virtue
