

This Indenture made the Thirtieth Day of Decemr in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and sixty nine Between Hankey alias Nagai Septer of the one party & William Smith and Ann his wife of the County of Spotsylvania in the Colony of Virginia of the other party Witnesseth that the said Hankey alias Nagai Septer of her own free will and Consent with herby Covenant promise & grant to and with the said Wm Smith & Ann his wife their Executors Admin^{rs} & Assigns from the day of the date hereof For and during the term of five years to come such service of employment as the said William Smith & Ann his wife or their Assigns shall think proper to employ her for the said Hankey alias Nagai Septer In Consideration whereof the said Wm Smith & Ann his wife doth con-
sent & grant to & with the said Hankey alias Nagai Septer to send and allow her sufficient meat Drink Apparel & Lodging with other necessaries during the said Term In Witness whereof the said parties above mentioned to these Indentures have interchangeably set their hands and seals the day and year first above Written

In the name of God amen I Henry Head of Spotsylvania County in the Colony of Virginia Planter being sick of body but of perfect sense and memory thank be to the Almighty God calling to mind the vanity of estate on man, and that all flesh must yield to death when it please God to call, I do make and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form following, First and principally I bequeath my soul into the hands of the Almighty God, not doubting, but trusting through the merits of and passion of Jesus Christ, my ransom and redeemer, to receive forgiveness of all my manifold sins and wickedness, and my body to the Earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named, and for what worldly estate I hath pleased God to bestow upon me, I give and bequeath in manner and form following, Item I give and bequeath unto my son Henry Head all my Estate whatsoever, as Negroes with household goods &c during my wife Francis Heads life time upon Condition

that my said son give my wife Francis half of the profits that shall arise of my said
 estate and after my said wife decease I give and bequeath as follows —
 Item I give and bequeath to my ^{son} Alexander Spencer Head one negro man named Matt, to
 him and his heirs forever — Item I give and bequeath to my son Benjamin
 Head this here forever one negro boy named Tom, Item I give and bequeath to my
 Daughter Mildred Edwards one negro woman named Judy and her increase
 that she the said Judy shall have from the estate hereof. Item I give and bequeath
 to my son Harry Head this here forever one negro woman named Sarah, and
 negro girl named Mamm with their increase that they shall have after the estate
 hereof and one negro boy named Dick, and I do give and bequeath to my said
 son Harry Head one feather bed and furniture after my decease and I desire
 that my son Benjamin Head is to be, at the signing of these, then the
 negro boy above mentioned named Tom, shall belong to my son Harry Head and
 after my wife Francis Head decease all my household goods & books & whatness
 to be Equally divided amongst my Children viz Alexander Spencer, Benjamin,
 Mildred and Harry and I do hereby appoint Francis Head to be my executor
 Head my Executor to this my Last will and Testament revoking & annul-
 ling all other will or wills by me made heretofore, In Witness whereof, I have
 hereunto set my hand & seal this twenty fifth day of February in the year of
 our Lord one thousand seven hundred and sixty five
