of Spotsylvania being weak in body but of sound mind and perfect memory thanks be to God do
make and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form following viz^d

First I do commend my soul to Almighty God who gave it, in hopes thro the merits of my
Blessed Saviour Jesus Christ to receive forgiveness of my sins, and my body to the earth
to be decently Buried by my Executors hereafter named

It is my desire that all my Debts & due and former Expenses be paid, and then
I give and bequeath my Estate that it hath pleased God to Bless me with in this
transitory life in the following manner viz^d

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah Stuart one hundred and fifty acres
of Land lying on the north side the main road under the land where my son in
law John Stuart now lives in Spotsylvania County, also one negro man named
York, together with my stock of every kind on grass and garden together
with all my household furniture of every kind whatever, and also what cash I
have in the house & in better then seven pounds the stock household furniture &
cash above given is intended to be that which I now live, the said given above to
be her & the heirs of her body lawfully begotten forever, and the above named negro
fellow York after the Death of my said Daughter Sarah and my son in law John
Stuart I give and bequeath to my grandson John Stuart to him and his heirs
forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my grandson Charles Stuart my house & land situate in
Dells

Item I give and bequeath to my son George Arnold the remaining part of my land & land
lying the south side of the main Road supposed to be computed to be under and left by
Acres be the same more or less and in the land where I now live in Spotsylvania County
to him and his heirs forever, also two negro fellows viz^d Charles & Toby together with all
my Estate of every kind whatsoever in King George County to whom I leave the care of his
Mother Sarah Arnold to have a sufficient maintenance out of the above Estate as
long as she lives

And Lastly I constitute and appoint my said son George Arnold Executor of
this my last will and Testament hereby revoking and annulling all other
wills hitherto made by me as witness my hand and seal this 24th day of
July 1770
