James Samms Died and find a balance due of personal Estate after the debts are Charged to amount to £99. 16. 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ we then allotted one third of the s^d Balance to the Administration being £33. 5. 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ and also set apart her dower in the Slaves amounting to £46. 15. 0 we then proceeded to settle the proportions of the remaining two third parts of the Slaves and personal Estate and have divided the same into six parts as by the account will appear, which several proportions are Charged to the heir at Law who has Credit given him for two third parts of the Slaves and personal Estate, given under our hands this 17th day of May 1777
