I John Battaly of the County of Spotsylvania and Parish of Saint George being sick and weak in body but of sound and perfect Sense and memory, do hereby declare this my last will and Testament in manner & form as followeth.
 Item My will and desire is that all the Lands I am now possessed of be sold by my Executors or so much thereof as will be sufficient to pay my Just Debts
 Item My will and desire is my beloved wife Elizabeth Battaly shall have and enjoy all my Estate both real and personal, to her and her heirs and assigns forever (my Just debts being first paid as aforesaid) allowing my brother Samuel Battaly and my sister Elizabeth Battaly a sufficient maintenance during life, which is discretionary in my Executors, but in case my wife should marry and it should be found that the Estate is wasting by the means of such marriage my will and desire is that my Executors shall then act as they think most proper. And Lastly I nominate and appoint my friends Messrs Edward Hendon, John Hendon & Joseph Hendon my whole and sole Executors of this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all former wills by me heretofore made and declaring this to be my last will and Testament. Witness my hand and seal this 7th day of September 1770, Signed sealed and Published by John Battaly as his last will & Testament
