 my Estate both real and personal

Item I give to my son Thomas Cain one hundred Acres of Land to him and his heirs forever

Item I give to my son Barnett Cain one hundred Acres of Land to him and his heirs forever

Item I have already given to my son William Cain one hundred Acres of Land to him and his heirs

Item I give to my son Robert Cain one hundred Acres of Land to him and his heirs

Item I give to my son George Cain fifty one Acres of Land to him and his heirs and fifteen pounds
 Current money to make his Land Equal with the rest of the Boys

Item I give to ^{all} my Daughters of my Personal Estate as much to each of them as to make their
 Portion Equal in value to the boys Land and all the rest of my Estate to be of what nature
 & kind ever I do live to be Equally divided amongst all my Children and if any of them

should die without any his Lawfully Begotten then their part to be Equally divided amongst
 the rest of my Children and it is my desire that the Children that have had any part of my
 Estate already it should be Brought in again or allowed for in their true part of my Estate
 and I do constitute and ordain my Two sons Thomas Cain and William Cain Executors
 fully and solely of this my present last will and Testament and I do hereby revoke Dissolve
 and make void all former wills and Testaments by me heretofore made and this only
 and no other to be taken for my last will and Testament In Testimony whereof I have
 hereunto set my hand and Seal this Twentyfifth day of July one thousand seven
 hundred and Sixty four Signed Sealed published and Delivered to be his last will
