 apparel to be equally divided among them also I give unto my
 Said four Sisters all the remainder of my Estate to them and
 their Heirs forever to be Equally Divided among them
 and Lastly I Nominate Constitute & ordain & appoint my
 Brother in Law Thomas James of the County of Westsylvania
 my whole and sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament
 hereby revoking all former Wills by me before made and
 Ratiffing & Confirming this only to be my last Will and
 Testament for witness whereof I have hereunto put my hand
 and affixed my seal this Twenty second day of July in the
 year of our Lord 1765
