In the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty nine Between Mr. Bullin Carpenter of Primer Wicofeth that the said Mr. Bullin by and with the Consent and Approbation of Spheylumia County Court hath put and bind himself from the Day of the date hereof apprentice unto the said Mr. Tahafero until he arriveth to the age of twenty one years he now being about twelve years old (During all which time the said Apprentice his said Master shall well and truly serve his secrets keep his Lawful Commandments always obey he shall not Destroy or imbragle any of his Mr. Tahafero's goods nor converse so he shall by any other person he shall not commit adultery or fornication nor contract matrimony within the said term neither shall he absent himself from his said masters service without leave but in all things shall behave himself as an Apprentice ought to do During the term aforesaid and the said Mr. Tahafero for his part doth covenant agree to and with his said Apprentice to teach him to teach and instruct him in his trade of a Carpenter & Joiner to feed and provide for his said Apprentice sufficient meat Drink Clothing Washing Lodging Banding and making getting for his said apprentice during the term aforesaid & learn him to read and write In Witness whereof the parties to these presents have interchangeably put their hands & affixed their seals the
