 First It is my desire that the money due to me be collected as soon as possi-
 ble after my Decease of the Billiard Table with such Household Furni-
 ture as can be spared be sold towards the due Payment of my Debts
 Item I Give & Devise to my son James Jewis & to his Heirs forever the two
 lots in y^e said Town which he purchased from M^r Anthony Stather
 he paying or causing to be paid to my two sons John & William in one
 year after he shall arrive at full Age, the sum of one Hundred
 Pounds Current money to each of them

Item I Give & bequeath to my said son James one Negro Girl named
 Judy to him and his Heirs

Item I Give & bequeath to my son John Jewis, one Negro Man named
 James to him and his Heirs

Item I Give & bequeath to my son William Jewis one Negro Boy Na-
 med Cuspay to him and his Heirs

And lastly, as to all the rest of my Estate of what kind or Nature
 soever I Give and bequeath to my Dear & Loving Wife Sarah Jewis
 During her Natural Life - towards her Support & Maintenance &
 that of my two sons Benjamin & George & after her Decease the
 whole to be divided Equally between y^e said Benjamin & George &
 their Heirs &c - hereby appointing my said Wife with my Friends
 Charles Yates Joseph Brock & Edward Herndon Executors and
 Executors of this my last will & Testament hereby Revoking all
 former Wills by me made. In Witness whereof I have hereunto
 set my hand & seal the 27th Day of January 1763

 being returned for the other 2^d named in the Will to appear in probat whey they shall think fit Test John Watts
