I William Miller of the County of Spotsylvania and Parish of Saint George being very Sick and weak in Body but of mind and Memory sound and perfect as usual do make this my Last will and Testament in Manner and form following that is to say I commend my Soul to God who gave it, and my Body to the Earth to be buried at the Discretion of my Executors Hereafter named and as to what worldly Goods it hath Pleased the Almighty to bestow on me I give in Manner and Form following

Imprimis it is my will and Desire that all my Just Debts and Funeral Expenses be first Satisfied and Paid.

Item my will and desire is that my beloved wife Jane Miller shall have the use of all my Estate both Real and Personal during natural Life, and after her Death to be disposed of as follows

Item I Give and bequeath to my Grandson William Miller Blessed the Land and Plantation whereon I now live, together with all the Land which at the time of my Death I shall have adjoining the same, but in case my said wife should die before my said Grandson comes of age then my desire is that my Daughter Betty enter into Possession and have the free use of the said Land and Plantation during the Minority of the said William Miller and that at the time of his coming to the age of Twenty one years he shall be entitled to the same which Land I hereby bequeath to him and the Heirs of his Body lawfully begotten forever, And whereas if the said William Miller Blessed should die without heirs of his Body I Give the said Land to his Brother Moses Blessed and his heirs and assigns forever

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Grandson William Miller Blessed, Miller Blessed and Moses Blessed all my Land in Orange County to be

equally divided amongst them in Quantity and Quality and it is
my desire that if my wife should die before either of them comes of age
that then my Daughters Mary & Betty Enter into Possession of the said
Land and have the same equally divided Between them to hold the
same with all Benefit and advantage Accruing therefrom until one of
the said Children comes of age and then I desire it may be divided into
three Equal parts as above mentioned of the Eldest to take his part of
the Remainder to be still kept by my said Daughters till the next
comes of age & still the last shall be Entitled to his share. But in
Case either of the said Children should die before they come to the age
of Twenty one years, then and in that Case I hereby Impower my
Executor or the Survivor of them to sell the part belonging to such
Child and the Money arising by such sale to be Equally divided amongst
the surviving Brothers and Sisters of the Deceased

Item I Give and Bequeath to my beloved Wife Jane Miller one Negro Girl
Named Sylvia to be disposed of as she thinks fit

Item after the Death of my wife my will and Desire is that all the remain-
der of my Estate be Equally divided Between my Daughters Mary &
Betty which Estate I lend unto them during their Natural lives, and at
their Decease I desire the same may be equally divided Amongst their
Children Respectively, that is the Children of each Mother to
Divide the Estate lent to the Mother

Item my desire is that my Executors be satisfied for their trouble, out of my Estate
Lastly, I do hereby Ordain, constitute and Appoint my beloved wife Jane Miller
and my friends Edward Barnum and Joseph Barnum Executors and
Executives of this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all other
wills by me heretofore made in Testimony whereof I have hereunto set
my hand & Seal this 21st day of October 1764.
