Lastly I appoint my loving wife Sarah and my Grandson James Hutchinson Executors and Executor of this my Last Will and Testament Hereby Revoking all other wills heretofore by me made In Witness whereof I have hereunto affixed my hand and seal this fourteenth Day of December one Thousand seven hundred & sixty one.
