that is now owing or shall be owing to me at the Time
of my Decease, from my sons Thomas & Benjamin
Waller and my son in Law Mr. Zachary Lewis, also I give
to my said son William Waller & to his Heirs forever six

Item. I desire my son William may receive the money
that is now owing or shall be owing to me at the Time
of my Decease, from my sons Thomas & Benjamin
Waller and my son in Law Mr. Zachary Lewis, also I give
to my said son William Waller, & to his heirs forever six
large silver spoons, an mourning ring which I had for
my late Husband, my large Bible & common prayer
Book and my neg^r woman Hester. ~~HP~~

Item. I give & devise to Ann Waller wife of William Waller
a Case of silver tea spoons & a large Elbow Chair and
a Book called the Christian Sacrifice to her & her heirs
forever. ~~HP~~

Item. I give & bequeath to my Daughter Mary, the wife of Mr.
Zachary Lewis a Chest of Drawers & a looking glass which
stands thereon, a Seal Skin Trunk with my wearing
Cloaths & linen & woollen, my riding Chair & harness
& my sorrel Horse, to her the said Mary & to her heirs
forever. ~~HP~~

Item. I desire my Ex^r to sell my neg^r woman Moll for the
most he can get for her. ~~HP~~

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After my funeral charges
paid, I have no more to do
my Estate, not herein before
said amongst all my friends &
my Executors shall direct & think proper.

I do hereby appoint my son William Waller Executor of this my
last Will & Testament as Witness my Hand this 2^d
Day of October 1758.
