the best of my Estate both Real and Personal to him and his
heirs forever which also I appoint and Ordain Executor of
my last will and Testament utterly Revoking all other
former wills by me at any time made do Appoint and
Ordain the my last will and Testament and my Devere
to that my Estate to be not appraised In Wine for whereof
I have begun to set my hand and seal this sixteenth
Day of November Anno Domini one Thousand eight hundred and fifty
