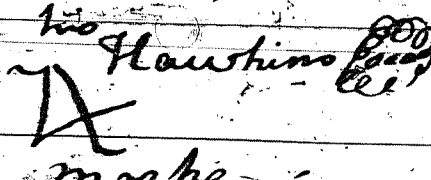


County being very sickly weak but of perfect sense & memory

Desire is that the above mentioned negro & her Increase Lent
to my wife after her Death to Return to my Son John Hawkins &
his heirs. Thirdly I Give to my Daughter Cateron Madan one
Shilling Sterling to be paid by my son John Hawkins, Forthly
I Give to my son James Hawkins the Land he now Lives on and all
the rest of the Personals Estate he now has in possession. Fifthly I Give to my
son Nicholas Hawkins the Land he now Lives on and all the
rest of the Personals Estate he now has in possession, Sixthly I Give
to my son Nathan Hawkins the Land he now Lives on & all the rest
of the Personals Estate he now has in his Possession, Seventhly I Give to
my son Alexander Hawkins one Negro Wench named Holladay
Jenny to him & his heirs. Eighthly I Give to my Daughter Ann
Pickett the Land she now Lives on & all the rest of the Personals
Estate she now has in Possession, Ninthly I Give to my son John
Hawkins the tract of Land whereon I now Live and Negroes,
Judy, Jacob, Gates, to him and his heirs and all the rest of my
personals Estate after my Just Debts are paid &

Will and Desire is that if my son John Hawkins should Die with-
 out heirs that the said Land should go to my son Mathan Hawkins &
 the Test of the Estate to be Equally Divided between my two sons
 Nicholas Hawkins and Alexander Hawkins. Unenthly I Give
 all the Estate my Daughter Catheron Macdand has in Possession to
 to my Grand Son ^{Hawkins} Catep. Lastly I do appoint my beloved wife and my
 son John Hawkins Executors to see this my Last will and Testament
 fulfilled & Complied with Revoking all other wills do hereunto set
 my hand and Seal this fifteenth day of february in the Year of our
 Lord one Thousand Seven hundred and fifty four. Inter Lined in the
