I do give & devise and bequeath unto my son Thomas
 Morris all my Land to him and the heirs of his body lawfully
 begotten for ever only reserving to my Loving wife Margaret
 Morris her life in the said Land and in Case my said son
 should die without such Issue then my will is that my said Land
 shall be Equally Divided between my two Daughters Mary &
 Sarah Morris and their heirs for ever.

I do give all the rest of my Estate to be Equally Divided
 in four parts between my Loving wife Margaret Morris &
 my son Thomas & my two Daughters Mary & Sarah Morris
 & their heirs for ever.

I do give unto my son William Morris one Shilling & no
 more.

I do give unto my son Joseph Morris one Shilling & no
 more.

I do give unto my two Daughters Elizabeth & Margaret
 one Shilling each in full of any dower they have or at any time
 hereafter may have in my Estate.

I do constitute constitute & appoint my Loving
 wife Margaret Morris and Lachry Gorton Executors of this my
 Last will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto
