Testament That is to say Principally and first of all I Give and
bequeath my soul into y^e hands of God that gave it: and my Body
I becomend to the earth. to be Buried in Decent Christian Burial
at y^e Discretion of my Executors not Doubting but at y^e General
Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power
of God and as Touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased
Almighty God to bless me in this Life I Give & dispose and
Dispose of y^e same in y^e following Manner and form
I Give in bequeath to my son Thibbles Warren Ninety five Acres
of Land which formerly I gave to my Daughter Ursula Thibbles
and the old Orchard and y^e convenient Pin bet to keep it under a fence
and also a negro Girl named Dilla and all her Increase

Item I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Broth A negro
girl named Marne to her and of heirs of her body

Item I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Mary Puffed and of
heirs of her body one Negro Boy named Sybil

Item I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Rockna More and of
heirs of her body one Negro Wench named Jenny and all her Increase

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my son Lancelot Warren all of Land
Belonging to of Plantation where I now Live and also one Negro
Wench named Pess after me and my wife Deceased

Item I give and Bequeath unto my loving wife Mary Warren
all of Part of my Estate During her life or widowhood and
after to be Equal Divided Amongst all my Children that
is Living at that time

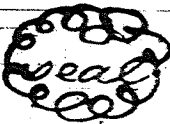
my Estate is not Indebted my will and Desire is it shall not be
Raised nor sold at Auction and that my Children Divide it
Equally amongst themselves and if they cant agree to Give
To me to Divide it Equally amongst them and if my Estate
at that time should be Indebted that if Debts be paid out of of
Inning Prop and if no Prop it is my will that if Debts
Be paid Out of my Estate before my Division

Likewise constitute make and Ordain my loving wife Mary
Warren and my son Hueley Warren my sole Executors of this
my Last will and Testament and Do here by Write as I will

my Last will and Testament and I do here by Utterly Dis-
avow and Disannul all and Every Other former Testament
with Legacies and Bequests and Executors by me in any way
before Named Will and Bequestes Ratifying and Confirming
This and no Other to be my Last will and Testament
