Buried in the Earth by my Executors hereafter named
I give and bequeath to my son Zachariah Garton all
my Land that I hold in Lancaster County & Part of my Makepon^{gh}
Land the Plantation whereon he now liveth with eighty Acres
adjoyning

I give and bequeath to my son Uriah Garton the Plantation
whereon I now liveth with eighty five Acres adjoyning to him
and his heirs forever

I to my son Elijah Garton I give and bequeath the Plantation
whereon Ephraim Threight now liveth of eighty five Acres adjoyning
to him and his heirs forever

I give and bequeath all my Personall Estate after my Debts & Legacies
of funerals Charges is paid to be Equally Divided between my Love
Wife Winnefide & my son sons (viz) Uriah Garton & Elijah
Garton

I do hereby constitute Authorise and Appoint my three sons
(viz) Zachariah Garton Uriah Garton & Elijah Garton my Executors
Jointly and severally of this my Last will and Testament to see
it executed in Witness Whereof I have set my hand & seal this

KNOW all men by these Presents that we Zachary Garton Uriah Garton
Thos. Brookes & Jno. Martin are held and firmly bound to William
Robinson William Carr Henry Willis of Beverly Winclose Gentlemen
Justices of the Court of Westsylvania County now sitting in the sum
of two Hundred Pounds current money of Virginia to the Payment
Whereof well and truly to be made to the said Justices and their Successors
We bind our selves of each of us our and each of our Heirs Executors or
Administrators jointly & severally firmly by these Presents Sealed With
our Seals this fifth day of August in the year of our Lord 1755 and in the
XXIXth Year of the Reign of Our Sovereign Lord King George the
Second

The Condition of this Obligation is that if the above
Bound Zachary Garton of Uriah Garton do make or cause to be made a true
and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods Chattels and Credits
of Uriah Garton deceased which have or shall come to the hands Possession
or knowledge of them the said Zachary Garton of Uriah Garton or into
the hands or Possession of any other Person or Persons for them or
the same or made do exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the County
Court of Westsylvania at such time as they shall be thereunto required
by the said Court and the same Goods and Chattels & Credits of the said
Deceased at the time of his death which at any time hereafter shall come
to the hands or Possession of the said Zachary Garton of Uriah Garton
or into the hands or Possession of any other Person or Persons for them do
well and truly administer according to Law and further do make a

Deeds at the time of his death which at any time hereafter I can come
 to the Hands or Possession of the said Zachariah Gaston & Uriah Gaston
 or into the Hands or Possession of any other Person or Persons for them do
 well and truly Administer According to Law and further do make a
 just and true Acc^t of their Actings and Doings therein When thereto
 required by the said Court and also do well and truly Pay and Deliver all
 the legacies Contained and specified in the said Testament as far as the
 said Goods Chattels and Credits will thereto extend According to the Value
 thereof and as the Law shall Charge them then their Obligation to be
 void Otherwise to Remain in full force and Virtue
