 after my just debts & legacies are paid I leave to be equally divided between
 my loving wife & my four grandsons & my will is that my grand-
 sons parts except the house brick middle of Gun be with and the money
 arising therefrom bedelged in the hands of my brother by name
 Edward Horning Fitzhugh just till they attain to the age of twenty-
 one years Lastly I appoint my loving wife to receive my
 whole and sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament and
