same do hereby declare make & Ordain this & this only to be
my last will & Testament hereby revoking annulling and
making void all other wills by me made in the following
manner First I recommend my soul to God who gave it in
hope for a free pardon for my sins at the resurrection and
my body to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors
hereafter named. And as to my worldly Estate which God has
blessed to bless me with I dispose off in the
following manner I give all my Estate except one hundred
and eighty four Acres of Land in Caroline County and
all negroes following named & Waggons to be Equally divided
between my loving wife Mary & my four children
John & Mary & John & Sarah & Mary of the said Children

Should die without a lawful heir then such child or part
shall be Equally divided among the rest of my will is that
at my wife's death her part shall be divided Equally among
the children. **Item** I give & bequeath to my son John
his share of the Land above mentioned in Maryland County
and if he should die without heirs then my desire is that
it be sold at public Auction to the highest bidder for Cash
to be Equally divided among the rest of my Children.
Item my desire is that the above mentioned negro
Waggon be hired out to support the schooling and
maintenance of my son John and if he die without
heirs then what the said negro shall earn shall be
Equally divided among the rest of my Children. **Item**
my desire is that the following things may be sold toward
the support of my family; vizt / the above furniture
and a clock & a chest of drawers & a pair of mirrors
AND lastly I do constitute & appoint my brother
Richard Murray my friend Richard Elkin to be my
whole executor of this my last will & Testament. **In**
