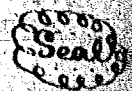

 his heirs forever and in case the ^s. John should die without heirs or
 making legal disposition thereof then to go and remain over to the
 Postrige another son of the said Sarah & if he should die without heirs
 or making legal disposition thereof then to the child the said Sarah
 now goes with in the same manner as before and the said Sarah
 Postrige to have the use of the same as long as she lives single to
 maintain the said children. **I give** to my nephew Thomas
 Durcom the gun that was his fathers **I give** the rest of
 my Estate in trust also to my friend Richard Bernard to be
 equally divided between the said Sarah and her children that are
 now living and the one that she goes with and that the said
 chattels may be kept together for the better maintenance of the

 Postrige my executrix of this my Will and Testament under the
