

On the 14th day of June 1748 I George Crooby being of perfect Sence and
Memory Prived be God for the same, I do make and Ordain this my Last
Will and Testament in manner and form as followeth Viz/ I Give
give and bequeath my now Dwelling Plantation to my dear and Loving
Wife Sarah Crooby during her life with all the Land and Appurtenances then
unto belonging and after her decease to my Son Uziel Crooby and his heirs
Lawfully begotten of her body and for want of such heir to the heir of my son
George Crooby and for want of such heir to the next heir at Law I Give
to my Son George Crooby one Large Bible and one Gun with a Trumpet muzzel
I Give and bequeath to my Dear & Loving wife Sarah Crooby two Negroes
Named Dick and John and after her Decease to my Son Uziel Crooby I Give
give and Bequeath to my son Uziel Crooby one Tract of Land lying on the head of
Aquia Containing two hundred Acres and to his heirs Lawfully begotten of his
own body and for want of such heir to the next heir at Law I Give & bequeath
to my dear & Loving wife Sarah Crooby all the rent of my Estate both real &
personal and at her decease to my son Uziel Crooby I Give & bequeath
my dear & Loving wife Sarah Crooby and my son Uziel Crooby & his heirs & assigns
of this my Last Will & Testament wholly renouncing and disavowing all other
Wills by me made before Allowing this & none but this to be my Last Will & Testament
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 14th day of
November 1748 at Stafford County Virginia George Crooby
Signed Sealed and Delivered in presence of Thomas Gough, B. Gough, W. Gough, M. Gough
all a Court held for said County at the 14th day of November 1748
I John Gough Deputie of George Crooby then was presented
in Court by Mary Crooby one of the Executrix therein named who was
