this my last will & Testament in manner & form following, that
is to say. First, & principally I commit my soul to Almighty
GOD my blessed Redeemer, my body to the Earth, there to be
honestly buried according to the direction of my Ex^{rs} hereafter
named. All my debts lawfully contracted I desire may be
honestly & justly paid, & then what worldly Estate, it has
pleased GOD to bless me with, I dispose of as followeth, in
this manner. I give & bequeath unto my loving son Charles
Prout, ten Bushells of Wheat. IWM I give & bequeath to
my loving son Hugh Prout, One sorrell Mare named Fly.
IWM I give & bequeath unto my loving son George Prout,
One English Colt, that stand of the sorrell mare. IWM I give
to my loving Daughter Ann Prout, One Bay horse Colt. IWM I
give to my loving Daughter Katherine Prout, five shillings
Current money. IWM I give to my Daughter Mary Loder, five
shillings Current money. IWM all the rest of my Estate, I give to
my two loving sons William Prout & George Prout to be equally
divided between them. Lastly, I nominate & appoint my loving
son Hugh Prout Ex^r of this my last will & Testament. In
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed
my seal this 5 day of February in the 8 year of our Sor 1762
