Fitzhugh five hundred Acres of Land where he now Lives being
Part of W. Kinsons Patent & bounded as followeth viz^t Beginning
the south East Corner of one hundred Acres of Land formerly leased
to John Sayton the older running from thence East one hundred fifty
Eight poles more or less to the East most Line of W. Kinsons Patent thence
along the d^y Line south three hundred & Twenty poles then west Two
Hundred fifty & Eight poles then north bounding on the Land formerly
Leased to Christopher Threlkell to the Land formerly Leased to
J^r. John Sayton the Elder then East one hundred poles more or less
to the Beginning the d^y Land to him my son Thomas & to his heirs
