sound mind & memory do make this my last will & Testament
I recommend my soul to almighty God hoping thro' the merits of
my Blessed Saviour Jesus Christ to obtain pardon of my sins &
Eternal happiness & I desire that my body may be decently buried at
the discretion of my Executor - I give and Devise to my son Thomas
Fitzhugh five hundred acres of Land where he now lives being
part of Wilkinsons Patent & bounded as followeth viz: Beginning
at the south east corner of one hundred acres of Land formerly leased
to John Taylor the older running from thence east one hundred fifty
Eight poles more or less to the eastmost line of Wilkinsons Patent then
along the said line south three hundred & Twenty four then west Two
hundred fifty eight poles then north bounding on the Land formerly
leased to Christopher Thrallhill to the Land formerly leased to
J: John Taylor the older than east one hundred poles more or less
to the beginning the said Land to him his son Thomas & to his heirs
for ever - I give to my son Thomas one moiety of my Tenant land
Land now in his possession according to a division lately made

Brother Henry to him my s^d son Thomas & to his heirs for ever
I give & Devise to my son John Fitzhugh the other moiety of my Great
Town Land now in his possession according to a Devision made by his

of Benjamin Coleclough Likewise all my lands within the bounds of
the Church Quarter Patent I had partly by a purchase from Robert Dale
& partly by a surplus Patent I give a thousand Acre to my son Henry & to the heirs
of his Body lawfully begotten for ever But should my son Henry have
or any claiming under him or them Lay claim to the five hundred acres
part of Wilkinsons Patent Devised to my son Thomas & his heirs or me
my s^d son Thomas or his heirs in the possession thereof then in that case
I give all thy Lands Devised to my son Henry Balfred to my son John
and his heirs for ever

I give and Devise to my son Henry Fitzhugh in Lieu & in consideration of those two hundred acres of Land part of Wilkinsons Patent Devised to me said son Thomas & his heirs & wheresoever of my d^r son Henry is then in Jail all that Tract of Land near Accotink Run which I bought of Richard Foote & others also one hundred acres of Land which I bought of Benjamin Colclough Letting ~~all~~ all my lands within the boundaries of the Church & Carter Patent I have partly by a purchase from Robert Davis & partly by a surplus Patent I give to my son Henry & to the heirs of his Body Lawfully begotten for ever but should my son Henry die before any claiming under him or thence day claim to those two hundred acres Part of Wilkinsons Patent Devised to my son Thomas & his heirs or male my d^r son Thomas or his heirs in that proportion thereof then in that case I give all the Land Devised to my son Henry & his heirs to my son Thomas and his heirs for ever.

I give & bequeath to my Daughter Susanna four hundred pounds Commodity of Virginia and five slaves vizt Lucy & her Son George Murdoch and Guss Pross sons & their future increase to her & her heirs forever I also give my d^r Daughter a good Bed & suitable Chamber
