The within last will and testament of John Washington deceased is hereby confirmed by William Bernard and John Washington two of the Executors thereof named who made oath thereto according to Law and being further sworn by the oath of Frances Stuart late Frances Washington, Frances Dorey, Richard Dorey and the witness thereto subscribed is admitted to be the true and lawful will of the said John Washington. In testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals at the City of New York the 10th day of June 1744.
