 and heirs for ever. Also I leave to my loving wife Mary
 suddenly one Muskego boy named to do with him as
 she thinks proper. Lastly I appoint my loving wife Mary
 suddenly my whole sole & part of this my last will & testament
 In witness whereof I have set my hand & seal this
 Jan'y 24th 1753.
