mon by the name of Foxmorton Run. being the half of eight
hundred Acres bought of Elizabeth Whit, And my desire is that
the said Abraham shall make his choice of the whole, part
for his four hundred Acres provided he takes it in one place.
And if the said Abraham shall die before he comes to the year
of maturity, then the said Abraham's four hundred Acres of
Land shall be equally divided between my two Grandsons
John Foley, son of John Foley, & James Foley, son of James.

rest of my Estate to my dear & loving wife Sarah and her son
Abraham Poole & my dear & loving children John Foley, &
my son James Foley & my Daughter Katherine Smart to be
Equally divided amongst them But if the said Abraham

Should die without issue, then his part of the said land, shall
 pass to the heirs of William McCarty, and I appoint my dear
 and loving wife Sarah Foley, and my son John Foley and
 my son James Foley Executors of this my last will and
 Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and seal this first day of September 1755.
