my son Thomas Sanderson one Negro man named Simon &
IEM my desire is, that all my Land & other Estate whatsoever
may be sold & kept my part of my mother's third, the money
arising by the sale of my Land & other Estate as aforesaid. my
will is for the maintaining & schooling of my children according
to the direction of my & hereafter mentioned. My will is that
these three Negroes as aforesaid which I have given to my three
sons William, John & Thomas, may be hired out 900^l by year
for wages to be applied as aforesaid for the use & support of my
children, and what profit arises there over & above by the sale of my
Land & other Estate with the three Negroes wages. IEM I give to my
two Daughters Sarah & Jane to be equally divided between them
My will & desire is, that after my mother's Death that that part
of my father's Estate to me by Inheritance given and bequeath
to my son William Sanderson &c. I do constitute & appoint
my wellbeloved Brother William Sanderson my sole heir &c.
and if case my brother William Sanderson's death or disability
I do constitute & appoint my loving friend William Cook my
&c. of this my last will & Testament. I hereby revoke all other
wills heretofore made by me In witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand & seal this 13. day of January 1759—
