debts owing to me (Littell household goods &c.) Item, It is my will and I do hereby order and
appoint that my dear wife whom I do hereby constitute and appoint sole executrix of this
my Last will and Testament after my decease sell or lease to be sold all my other lands
whatsoever. Item, it is my will and desired that the money or Tobacco arising by the sale
of such other Lands shall be for the discharging of such debts as shall be by me owing
at my decease and that the Remainder be Equally divided between my wife and daughter. Item,
It is my will and order to my executrix that she suffer my Estate to be brought to apprais-
ment Item, if it should please God that I depart this life in my own house then it is my
Request that I be buried in the Churchyard at Aquia Church on the South side and that
there be a funeral sermon but that the Service of the dead be read by some one of my
acquaintance as my wife shall think fit and yet to be performed in the presence of some
few of my Neighbours. Item, It is my will and desire that at the head of my grave shall
be set up on which shall be put my name the day of the month and year of the year wherein
