Saint Pauls in the County of Stafford being in a very low State of
Health but of perfect mind & memory thanks be to GOD, do
make this my last will, in manner & form following, that is to
say, I commend my soul into the hands of Almighty GOD, and
my body I leave to be buried at the discretion of my Ex^{rs} hereafter
named, And as for touching the disposition of all such Temporal
Estate as it hath pleased GOD to bestow on me, I give & bequeath
as followeth. Item I give & bequeath to my beloved wife
Ann Brown all my Estate Real & Personal, during her natural
life or widowhood, and if my said wife Ann should marry or
any way dispose of my Estate otherwise than ^{what} is hereof say, for
her useful wants, then my will is that my Ex^{rs} shall divarment
her from any part of my Estate, And after her decease if she should
comply with this my will, then I give my Estate as followeth
Item I give & bequeath to James Woot son of James Woot of
King George County my Negro boy named Tom, to him & his
heirs for ever. Item I give & bequeath to Elizabeth Woot
Daughter of the afores^d James Woot my Negro boy named Sam to
her & her heirs for ever. Item I give & bequeath to Eleanor Woot
Daughter to the said James Woot my Negro boy named Aaron
to her & her heirs for ever. Item I give & bequeath to Margaret
Bator, One Cow & all

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Of my Estate both Real & Personal after my wife's decease should
descend to the children of the said James Went Senr that shall be
lawfully born to the said James Went. I Do here - Constitute &
appoint my beloved friends James Went & James Llanedding
Executors of this my last will & Testament by me made hereby
revoking all other wills & Testaments formerly by me made
confirming this to be my will In witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand & fixed my seal this 5th day of Nov. 1760
