both personal and real with paying first my debt and then my Legacies
and I desire none of my Estate to be brought to appraisement and I do
appoint my Youngest Son Henry Burras sole heir and Executor of
my whole Estate with paying my Legacies and I do Ordain this my
Will to be my last last Will by me made and all other Wills by me made
to be of no effect and this my last Will to stand in full force whomever I have
intentionally set my hand and put my Seal this 3. day of December 1746
