in Body but of perfect sense & memory thanks be given to God do ordain this my
Last will and Testament in manner & form following. In witness I Commit my
Soul into the hands of almighty God assuredly believing I shall have full pardon
remission from all my sins, & through the Death & merits of my only Saviour
and redeemer Jesus Christ next I Commit my Body to the Earth to be Decently
Buried at the Discretion of my Ex^{ors} hereafter Nominated and as for such
Mortally Estate which hath Pleased God to bestow upon me I Give Devise &
Dispose of in the following manner & form - Item I Give & bequeath unto my
Grandson Thomas Shotton my old Plantation with one hundred & fifty acres
of Land my negro woman named Judy my Bed & Bedclothes & her wardrobe & as
touch box one Bed & furniture to him & his heirs for Ever. Item I Give &
bequeath unto my Grandson Wm Turner my Plantation with one hundred
with one hundred & fifty acres of Land one negro woman named Robin the bed &
furniture that lies on one Horse Bed & I Give to him & his heirs for Ever
Item I Give and bequeath unto my Grandson Bononi Shotton five or
hundred & twenty five acres of Land to him and his heirs for Ever
Item I Give and bequeath unto my Grandson John Turner Senior one hundred
and twenty five acres of Land one bed and furniture to him & his heirs for Ever
Item my will is that after all my Last Debts are paid that the residue of my Estate
be Equally Divided between all my Grandchildren & Daughters my two
