as my last Will I give & Commit my Soul into the hands of God who gave
it hoping through the merits of my Saviour that I shall be pardoned
for all my Sins & my body to the ground to be Dearly buried as my
Ex^{or} shall think fit from I give & bequeath to my Dear wife Elizabeth
all the Estate that I had or shall have with her from her Dorsed
father & Brother I leave to her & her heirs for ever from I give &
bequeath to my said wife all my Land lying in the Parish of
Chappawamsuk during her natural life but if my wife is now with
Child then my will is that after my wife Dorease I then give the said
Land to the said Child to its heirs for ever & if the said Child should
die before it arrives to the age of twenty one or leaves heirs of its body
lawfully begotten then I give the said Land to my Son Robert Jones
the son of my tute Robert Jones & to his heirs for ever from I leave
my Dear & loving wife my estate & I do give of the my last Will &
Testament containing in reverse side of a sheet of paper in witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the 2nd day of January
1733.
