A Nuncupative Will of Thomas

Williams proved by the Oaths of Alexander Douglass John Smith &c Francis Mello Witnesses present at the making thereof and that the Testator at the time of pronouncing the same did bid these persons aforesaid being present to bear witness that such was his Will and that it was made in the time of the last sickness of the deced^d at his dwelling house in Stafford County where he had been a Resident for many years he died the 11th of November 1753 & proved the next day his Will as follows, I do give unto Simon Rogers my mare & Colt called Lily I do leave Leonard Martin my gun & young woad horse saddle & furniture and that he be sold for money but not to receive it till he comes to age the remaining part of my Estate to be likewise sold & one half to my sister Sarah Douglass Children to them their heirs & assigns & the other half to my sister Ann Smith Children & their heirs & assigns I give my Middy Betty to Francis Mello to his heirs & assigns I give my servant woman to Alexander Douglass & John Smith to serve them one year after term I give her I give to my grandson between one & young horse to be paid when he comes of age at the price of two pounds
