

In the name of GOD I Townshend Dadd of the County of Staff
 and Parish of Saint Pauls being at this time sick & weak but of perfect
 sense & Memory praised be GOD and as touching such goods & Estate
 as it hath pleased GOD to bestow on me, doth think proper to dispose
 of in the following manner. First I give to my Daughter Elizabeth
 Washington Ditch, Virgin & her heirs all which she has in her
 possession to her, & her assigns for ever. Secondly I give to my Grand
 Son John Dadd one Negro man named Duba. Thirdly I give to my
 son Baldwin Dadd, two Negro men called Solomon & George.
 Fourthly I give to Sarah Dadd widow of Cadwallader Dadd one Negro
 Boy & Suky. Fifthly I give to my Daughter Frances Stuart the follow-
 ing Negroes John, Kate, & Mary & their heirs all which she has in her
 possession. Sixthly I give to my son Horatio Dadd the following
 Negroes Harry, Sally, Daniel, & Myos, & their heirs all which I am
 giving to my loving wife Rosa Dadd, to hold & use as she shall see cause. Lastly
 I give to my son Horatio Dadd all the rest of my Estate of what kind
 soever both real & personal. My will is that the tobacco in France
 & the crop of tobacco I have by me, be equally divided between
 my wife Rosa Dadd, & my son Horatio Dadd. Lastly I do constitute and
 appoint my loving wife and my son Horatio Dadd Executors of this my
 last will & Testament touching & disannulling all other wills by me made
 Whereunto I have set my hand & seal this 9th day of April 1761

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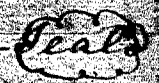

so ever both real & personal. My will is that the tobacco in hands
hands & the crop of tobacco that are by me, be equally divided between
my wife Rose Dadd, & my son Horatio Dadd. Lastly I constitute and
appoint my loving wife and my son Horatio Dadd Executors of this my
last will & Testament touching & disannulling all other wills by me made
Whereunto I have set my hand & seal this 9th day of April 1761

At a Court hold for Stafford County June the 9th 1761
The within last will & Testament of Townsend Dadd out & read was
presented in Court by Horatio Dadd Gent^l one of the Ex^{rs} therein named, who
made Oath the Oath according to Law, and being further proved by the Oath
of the witnesses thereto is admitted to record, And on motion of the said
Ex^{rs} the performing what is usual in such Cases, Certificate is granted
him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form.
