In the name of God Amen I Francis Bamer of the County of Surry in Swains Creek Parish being in a Weak and Low condition of body but of a sound and perfect mind and Memory praise be therefore given to Almighty God do make and Ordain this my present Last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say first and Principally I commend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God hoping through the Merits Death and Passion of my Saviour Jesus Christ to have full and free Pardon and forgiveness of all my Sins and to Inherit Everlasting Life and my body I commend to the Earth to be decently buried at the Discretion of my Executor hereafter named and as touching the disposition of all such Temporal Estate as it hath pleased Almighty God to bestow upon me I Give and Dispose thereof as followeth first my Will that all my Debts and Funerall Charges be paid and Discharged

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Loving Wife Mary Bamer all my whole Estate within doors and without Goods and Chattles whatsoever to her and her heirs and if she should die without heir lawfully begotten of her body my Will and desire is that it should be Equally Divided between Martha Garrett Daughter of George Garrett and Mary Bamer Daughter of William Bamer to them and their heirs

Item I Give and bequeath after my Death to Jane Travis thirty Shillings to her and her heirs

I Nominate and Appoint my Loving Wife to be my whole and Sole Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament and I doe hereby revoke Disannull and make Void all former Wills and Testaments by me heretofore made In Witness Whereof the said Francis Bamer to this my Last Will and Testament have set my hand and fixed my Seal this 4th of June in the Year of Our Lord Christ 1729
