In the Name of God Amen I James Nicholson of Surry County being Sick and weak in body but of
perfect Sense and memory therefore declare and Ordain this my Last Will and Testament in manner as followeth
first and p^{ri}ncipally bequeath my Soul into the hands of Almighty God my Creator and Jesus Christ my
Redeemer fully trusting in his merits for Remission of all my Sins and for what Estate it hath pleased God
to bless me with in this Life I do dispose of as is hereafter expressed

Secondly I Give to my Loving wife Eliza the use of my Plantation and Land during her natural Life and after her
Death I Give the plantation whereon I now live and all the Land thereunto belonging as far as a white Oak
that stands in Gilbert Grays line and soe crossing my Land to the head of a branch and soe down that branch
to the Gleebe line unto my Son James Nicholson to him and his heirs for ever and all the rest of my Land
after the death of my wife I Give to my Son Benj. Nicholson and his heirs for ever

Thirdly I bequeath all the rest of my Estate after my last Debts are paid unto my Loving wife Elizabeth whom I
also appoint Ex^{or} of this my Last Will revoking all former Wills unto which I have hitherto sett my hand and
Seal this 6th day of December 1722
