Testament in manner following first & principally & for above all worldly things and enjoyments  
I bequeath my soul to God the father of all Mercys trusting and firmly believing through the  
merits & bitter passion of his Son & my alone saviour Jesus Christ to receive full pardon and  
remission of all my sins wher ever this Mortall Life shall leave my body I comitt to the Earth  
from whence it was taken to be decently Interred after the manner of Christian buriale at the Discrea-  
tion of my Executrix hereafter named & for what worldly Estate it hath been pleased the Lord to  
befall on me after my Debts & funeral Expences are defroyed I dispose of in manner & forme  
following.

Item. I give and bequeath to my son John Seward and to his heirs for ever one halfe of that my Tract  
or Parcell of Land by me purchased of Thomas Bins to be laid of Next to Steen Starkes line.

Item. I give and bequeath to my loving wife all y<sup>e</sup> left & Remaining Part of that my said Tract or Parcell of Land  
by me purchased of Thomas Bins during her naturall life and after her Decease I give and bequeath  
all that Part of my Aforesaid Land as I have hearein given to my wife during her life to my son James  
Seward and to his heires for ever <sup>my Father give and bequeath to my said wife and to my son James</sup> — — — — —  
said wife all my crop of Corn & Tobacco provided she pay my Rent and Lavy this year — — — — —  
Item. I further give and bequeath to my said wife the Labour of my Negro girl — — — — —  
Tanny until my son John come to the Age of Eighteen years and then my will and desire is that  
my said Negro girl Tanny and all her Increase be Equally Divided between all my Children & their  
heires each of them to have an equall Part or Portion with the rest — — — — —

Item. I give and bequeath to the child my wife is now big with Tenn pounds Current money let it be  
either Son or Daughter.

Item. I give and bequeath all the rest and Remainder of my Estate of what nature soever & whatsoever  
that I have not already bequeathed to be Equally divided between my wife & children each of them  
to have an equall Part or Portion with the rest as well that as is not born as them as is born — — — — —

Item. I do hereby constitute and Appoint my loving wife my whole & sole Executrix of this my Last  
Will and Testament and do make void all former Wills by me made and declare this to be my  
last Will and Testament in testimony of all which I have hearein put my hand & seal this —
