I John Clark of the County of Surry being sick and weak of Body but of sound and perfect mind and memory thanks be therefore given to Almighty God do make and ordain this my present Last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say first and principally I commend my Soul into the hand of Almighty God hoping through the merits of my Saviour Jesus Christ to have full and free Pardon and forgiveness of all my sins & to inherit everlasting Life and my Body I Commit to my Earth to be decently buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter Named and as for my Temporall Estate which it hath pleased God to bestow upon me I give and Dispose thereof as followeth first I will that my debts and funeral charges be paid and discharged.

- Item I will that my Daughter and her husband keep the plantation they now live on During their naturall life after their Decease I give it to my Grandson John Barham and the heirs of his body forever and for want of such heirs I give it to my Grand Daughter Elizabeth Barham and the heirs of her body.
- Item I will that my Grandson Robt Barham have my plantation and all the Land belonging to it which I bought of James Briggs for him and the heirs of his Body for ever and for want of such heirs to my Grand Daughter Mary and the heirs of her body for ever.
- Item I give and bequeath to my Grandson Charles Barham my Gun.
- Item I give to my Daughter Eliz Barham my Gray horse Turk
- Item I give to Edward Harris my Scrimper and belt.
- Item I give and bequeath all the Rest and Residue of my Personall Estate to Mary my well beloved wife and do appoint her whole and sole Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament and I do hereby Revoke Disanul and make Void all former Wills by me made heretofore In witness whereof I have unto sett my hand and Seal the 2. Day of October 1711.

This Indenture made this fourteenth day of May in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and seventeen Between William Ranye Junr: of the Parish of Southwark in the County of Surry of the part and John Jones of the same Parish and County of the other part witnesseth that the said William Ranye for the rents and covenants hereafter mentioned let leased and to farm letten and by these presents the said William Ranye doth for himself his heirs Ex: &c let lease and to farm Lett unto the said John Jones his heirs Ex: &c one certain Tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being on the South West Side of the Accoon Swamp in the County aforesd: containing by Estimation one hundred and fifty Acres be it more or less & bounded viz: Westerly on the Land of Wm Vincent and the other boundarys of it is as is mentioned in y^r S^r Ranyes Patent for the same Dated y^r Thirteenth day of November one thousand Seven hundred and Thirteen may appear including the said one hundred & fifty Acres of Land more or less &c To have and to hold y^r S^r Land hereby Granted together with all houses Orchards Gardens woods underwoods ways Pastures feedings waters & water courses thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the s^r John Jones his Ex: &c for and during the term of three years to commence from the day of the Date hereof fully to be compleated and ended yeilding and paying for the same yearly & every year on the tenth day of Decemb^r yearly unto y^r S^r William Ranye his Ex: &c the fee Rent of one grain of Indian Corne if the same shall be lawfully demanded to the intent and purpose that by virtue of these presents and of the Statute for Transferring Uses into Possession the said John Jones may be in actuall and peaceable possession & seizer of the premises & might be thereby the better enabled to accept of a grant of the Reversion & Inheritance thereof to him and his Heirs for ever In witness whereof the said Wm Ranye hath hereunto sett his hand & affixed his seal the Day and year first above written Signed Sealed & Delivered.
