In the Name of God Amen I John Evens of the Lower Parrysh of Surry County being very sick and weak in body but in Perfect Science and Memory Praised be God for it and considering the uncertainty of this Life and that all Men are Mortall, do make & recd^t this my Last Will and Testament First I bequeare my Soul to God that gave it me and my body to the Earth from whence it was taken To be buried after a Christian like manner as my Exec^r shall think fitt and as for the Rest of my Worlly goods as it hath pleased God to bestow on me in this Life There dispose of them in manner & form as followeth.

- I do give my Land and Plantation on the South side of the Seacock Swamp to be sold by my Ex^r as Personall Estate.
- I give to my well beloved wife Mary Evens My bed ches and all the furniture Upally belonging to it.
- I give to my son John Evens one small Gun with These Letters upon it. IE and on each sword.
- And I do Appoint my Well beloved Wife Mary Evens my whole Ex^r & after my Debts and Legacies paid Then my Estate to be Equally divided between my wife and three children and I do Own this to be my Last Will and Testament Disanulling all other former Will that hath been made by me As Wittness my hand and seall the day and year first above Written.
