I give and bequeath the Labour of my Negro Jack to my Loving wife during her naturall Life or widowhood and after her death or marriage which shall first happen, I give the Labour of the said Negro to my Son George Jarrett for the Space of two years and afterwards I give the said Negro to my Son Richard for Ever, but if my said Son Richard should be dead before the said Negro comes to him and leave no Child then my will & devise is that the said Negro be sold by the Sheriff of the County at publick Auction and the money he fetches Equally divided between my two daughters Martha & Mary in three parts.

Item,

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Martha, one new feather bed and furniture.

Item,

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary one new feather bed and furniture.

Item,

I give and bequeath unto my Son George Jarrett fifteen wunable calves of five months old.

Item,

I give and bequeath all the Rest and Remainder of my Estate, both be of what nature of quality soever to be Equally divided between my wife and Children, Each of them to have an Equall part in the rest.

Item,

I do hereby make ordain and appoint my Loving wife Mary and my Son Richard my whole and sole Ex^{ors} and make void all wills heretofore by me made and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament.
