made the Nineten day of May in the year of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred and Nineten between Charles Gilliam of the P^{ar}ish of Bristol in the County of Prince George of the one part and Fletcher Mayberry of the parish of Southwark in the County of Surry of the other part Witnesseth that the said Charles Gilliam for and in the Considerations hereafter Mentioned, that is Six hundred pounds of Tobacco and ten Shillings Sterling money to him in hand paid by the said Fletcher Mayberry before the Enscaling and Delivery hereof the Receipt whereof the said Charles Gilliam doth hereby acknowledge and himself therewith fully Satisfied Contented and paid and thereof doth acquit and Discharge the said Fletcher Mayberry and his heirs Executors and assigns And hath by these Presents Given Granted bargained and Sold And doth hereby Give Grant bargain and Sell unto the said
