I Mary Hodge of Surry County videlicet being in good health of body, & of sound & perfect mind & memory praise be therefore given to Almighty God do make and Ordain this my present Last Will & Testament in manner & form following that is to say First & principally commend my soul into the hands of Almighty God, hoping thro' the Merits, Death & Passion of my Saviour Jesus Christ to have full & free pardon & forgiveness of all my sins & to inherit everlasting life And my body I committ to the Earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executor hereafter named And as touching the disposition of all such temporal Estate which it hath pleased Almighty God to bestow upon me I give and dispose thereof as follo —

I will that all my Debts & Funeral charges be paid and Discharged —

I give and bequeath unto my son John Hodge one breeding Year —

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Rebecka Tye one breeding Yew —

I give and bequeath unto my Granddaughter Judith Wilson two Pewter dishes to be delivered to her when she attains the age of twenty one years or Marries —

All the rest & residue of my Estate Goods & Chattells whatsoever I do give & bequeath unto my Daughter Martha Hay & her heirs —

And I do Order & Appoint my Son in Law Peter Hay full & sole Execut of this my Last Will and Testament desiring my Estate may not be Appraised — And I do hereby revoke disanull and make void all former Wills and Testaments by me heretofore made In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this eighth day of Jun<sup>r</sup> in the year of our Lord 1728.

This Indenture Made the third day of June in the first year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the second by the Grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the faith &c Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred twenty eight Between Elizabeth Warren and William Warren of the County of Surry of the one part and Robert Warren of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Eliz: Warren & William Warren for and in consideration of a sum of five shillings of Lawfull mony of England to them in hand paid by the said Robert Warren at and before the Ensealing and Delivery of these Presents the Recipci wherof and themselves therewith fully contented and paid they doth hereby acknowledge for divers good causes & Considerations them therunto moving hath granted bargained sold and Demised leased and to farm letten and by these presents doth grant bargain sell Demise lease and to farm lett unto the said Rob: Warren his heirs Exec: Administrators and Assigns all that tract or parcell of Land wherin the s: Rob: Warren now Lives in Southwark Parish in the County of Surry aforesaid containing two hundred and <sup>ninty</sup> acres land be the same more or less bounded as followeth Beginning at Sion Hills line against the head of the Gibbons then along the saif Hills line to a corner tree being a corner tree between the said Land and Gibbons land then along Gibbons line to the branch that divides the s: Lys: and Allen Warrens Land then down that branch to the Wild Swamp then down the Wild Swamp to the mouth of hoggen swamp then up hoggen swamp to a line of Markt trees that divides the s: Land and Elizabeth Thomas's Land then along the said line to a hickory being a corner tree in the Swamp then up the Swamp to the first Stacon with all Mesuages Tenements houses out houses gardens orchards fields Woods Underwoods Meadowes pastures feedings Swamps Marshes ways Waters Water Courses together w: the Loyalts of hunting hawking fishing & fowling and all mines Mineralls & Quarrys & all other Priviledges advantages Profits Comoditys & Appurtenances whatsoever to the s: demised Premises belonging or in any wise appurtenant together also w: all Yearly Rents and Profits referred in any Lease or Demise of any part of the Premises To have and to hold the s: Demised Premises and every part thereof with the Appurtenances unto the s: Rob: Warren his heirs Exec: Administrators and Assigns from the day of the date hereof for and during the full term and time of three Years to be fully compleated and ended Yielding and Paying therefor yearly On the tenth day of December to the said Eliz: Warren & William Warren their heirs Exec: Administrators or Assigns One grain of Indian corn if it be demanded to the Intent & Purpose that by virtue of these Presents and of a Statute for transferring uses into Possessions the s: Robert Warren may be in quiet & peaceable Possession of the Premises before granted and may be thereby the better enabled to accept of a grant or conveyance of the Reversion & Inheritance thereof to him and his heirs for ever In Witness Whereof the s: Eliz: Warren & William Warren hearunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written
